Minutes from the September 2018 Regular Meeting

President/KG5SDD called the meeting to order at 1929. Vice-President/WG1GEM, Treasurer/KG5YRW, Adviser/N5TLT, and Secretary/KE0MXN were present. There were eight voting members, one non-voting member, one proxy voting member, and seven non-members. Quorum requirement was certified by Secretary/KE0MXN.

President's Report:

Introductions: Jacob / KG5SDD introduced all members at the meeting.

Format of Meetings: Jacob / KG5SDD presented the format and proper decorum for W5AC regular business meetings.

Secretary's Report:

May Minutes: Jace / KE0MXN read the May 2018 meeting minutes. Jacob / KG5SDD requested a vote, which was motioned and seconded. The minutes were adopted as read.

Constitution Amendment: Jace / KE0MXN presented the constitutional amendments proposed on June 4, 2018. That amendment was tabled until the October meeting per point of order requested by Martin / W5MHN.

Website: Jace / KE0MXN reported on the state of the website, Joshua / AG5JH, proposed switching to the HUGO CMS.

Treasurer's Report:

Accounts: Max / KG5YRW delivered the balances for the W5AC accounts: Texas A&M Amateur Radio Club: \$2033.71, Amateur Radio Test Fees for ARRL: \$21.40, Donation: \$430.31.

Vice Presidents's Report:

Mess Hall: Connor / WG1GEM remarked that the mess hall will have mostly liquids for the 2018-2019 school year, due to the previous year's rat infestation.

T-shirts: Connor / WG1GEM reported that a new order for shirts ought to be placed, as they sold well at the Belton Hamfest. The new-edition shirts cost \$10, while the old-edition (only available in miscellaneous sizes) will be \$5 for this school year.

Historian's Report:

Dave / W5QZ was unable to attend the meeting, the historian's report was read by Jace / KE0MXN.

College Amateur Radio Callsign History:

- **Prior to 1912:** any station could operate without restriction
- **1912:** The titanic sank, so governments regulated wireless activity, in the U.S., the format was one number (district) and two letters, the first of which could not by X,Y, or Z.
- **W5AC:** W5AC, then 5AC is the third callsign issued in the 5th district
- Y stations: ROTC stations would adopt Y-first letter callsigns, but had stricter requirements for operations
- **5XB:** experimental stations would adopt X-first letter callsigns, and 5XB (W5AC) holds record for "Longest contact between two spark stations"

Director of Repeater Operations:

Nothing to report, Not present.

Club Business:

Constitution: The June 4th, 2018 edition of the constitution will be voted upon in the next meeting.

Repeater repair: Connor / WG1GEM reported that the IRLP node is down the iGate on the Richardson Building is down, Kevin / N5TLT responded that the repeater has ID errors and that the 146.820 repeater has been modified to prevent constant transmit.

Tower/Antenna repair: Kevin / N5TLT and Eric / KE5ISM noted that the antenna still needs repair (tuned), and that the feed line needs taken care of, but W5AC is still waiting on a date to carry out maintenance work from the leader of that project, Dave / W5QZ.
