Officer Reports

- President's Report
 - **T-Shirts**: KG5SDD reported that little has changed since the last meeting. The club is looking into getting t-shirts.
 - Prayer of Invocation: The club voted without opposition not to hold a prayer of invocation for the April Meeting.
 - **Water Damage:** KG5SDD noted that the shack has a hole in the storage area. KZ3G remarked that to prevent further damage, the club needs to get sheet rock in place quickly.

Vice President's Report

- In WG1GEM's absence, KE0MXN and KI5CLW read the Vice President's Report.
- Repeater Intermodulation: KEOMXN reported that the repeater intermodulation is back, despite trying to split to two antennas. KI5CLW remarked that PL-encode-follows-COR is a possible (temporary) solution, and that Connor has the CG control board to make the modifications.

- **Resolution 2018–2019–1R:** KI5CLW motioned to accept the resolution. KI5CWD seconded the motion. The motion passed without opposition, with W5MHN abstaining. The meeting of the quorum requirement of nine members was certified by KE0MXN.
- Resolution 2018-2019-2R: KI5CLW motioned to accept the resolution. KI5CWD seconded the

- Resolution 2018–2019–3R: KZ3G noted that he volunteers to pick up anyone at the shack who feels unsafe. The Club discussed the amendment and decided to strike point 2, and add point 2: "Ask all members left alone at the shack to call out on the repeater" and point 3: "Add a sign to remind members to notify others of their departure" and point 4: "Ask Kevin to investigate lighting and getting the statues removed." Multiple members noted that the statue outside was creepy and limiting membership. KI5CLW motioned to accept the resolution. KZ3G seconded the motion. The motion passed without opposition, with W5MHN abstaining. The meeting of the quorum requirement of nine members was certified by KE0MXN.
- Resolution 2018-2019-4R: Multiple members motioned to table the resolution. The resolution was
 tabled without opposition. The meeting of the quorum requirement of nine members was certified
 by KEOMXN.
- **Resolution 2018–2019–5R:** KI5CLW motioned to accept the resolution. KG5VGM seconded the motion. The motion passed without opposition, with W5MHN abstaining. The meeting of the quorum requirement of nine members was certified by KE0MXN.
- **P2P Network:** Multiple members motioned to approve the purchase. The motioned passed without opposition. The meeting of the quorum requirement of nine members was certified by KEOMXN.

Club Business

- Old Business
 - CQ Muster: KEOMXN et al. reported that on 21 April 2019, the club will hold CQ Muster net at 1900, with the VHF net being move to 2100 on the same day. The executive committee is still looking for volunteers to run this event. The CQ Muster will be held from 19-22 April 2019. This current basic schedule plan was proposed: 0900-1700L on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, with

- various modes on HF during this time. At 1800L on Sunday, have the HF net (conditions permitting), and then continue at-will until campus Muster on Monday.
- Work Meeting: KZ3G questioned why the rotor repair was on the slide but without a date. KEOMXN, KZ3G, et al. discussed the course of action, and decided to hold a work meeting on Saturday, 13 April 2019 at 1000L at the shack to repair the spare rotor. The discussion determined that molybdenum grease, crescent wrenches, and solvent would be necessary to complete the rotor repair.
- ARRL School Club Roundup: KEOMXN noted that the club ranked fifth in SCR for February 2019.
- QSL Cards: The club voted for the Howdy! Cards, but KI5DRO remarked that he would purchase the old design if requested. W5MHN noted that for CQ Muster, cards could be printed at Copy Corner if desired.

New Business

- MSC Open House: KEOMXN and KG5SDD reported that the club will be participating in the fall MSC Open House, and that the Executive Committee will authorize payment. KG5SDD remarked that the club should investigate new demonstrations, such as using the Flex Radio Maestro, or something with a waterfall display. KI5BVJ and KI5CLW suggested remote operation of the Flex radio from inside the MSC.
- CQR Log: After the club voted in favor of resolution 2018–2019–1R, KE0MXN presented on how to use CQR Log to log contacts for W5AC.
- **Presentations:** KEOMXN and KG5SDD noted that the club ought to emphasize presentations in the coming school year. KG5VGM noted that this was the role of the vice president, and that a resolution was unnecessary.
- WWV: KEOMXN noted that W8EDU and David Kazdan are looking to research Doppler shift of WWV signals and that W5AC has volunteered to host a node if they are successful in applying for a grant. KZ3G noted that W5AC ought to ask if they need any help getting approval for the grant.
- P2P Network: KEOMXN remarked that WG1GEM is looking to purchase a P2P link for the club to connect the repeater to N5BRZ's network for reliable AllStar, IRLP, and Echolink on the repeater.
 WG1GEM requested \$300 for the project, which was approved.
- Club Drive: KE0MXN reported that KZ3G had requested a central resource for W5AC documents, and that a Google Team Drive had been created for that purpose. Interested members should contact the club officers.

Good of the Order

- W5BCS Meeting: The W5BCS meeting will be held on 20 April 2019 at 0930L.
- W5AC March Meeting: KI5CWD requested that the W5AC May meeting be moved to 23 April 2019. The motion passed without opposition. [See Addendum]
- TSPOTA: TSPOTA will be on April 13-14, 2019.
- K6RO: Special Event Station will be on air in April.
- WW0WWV: Signups to operate for WW0WWV in September are open.

- 3. Ask the EC and Advisors to develop a checklist for standard tower procedures (raising, lowering, tilting).
- 4. Require the entire EC and both advisors to be trained in standard tower procedures and briefed on the PHA/HAZOP outcomes.
