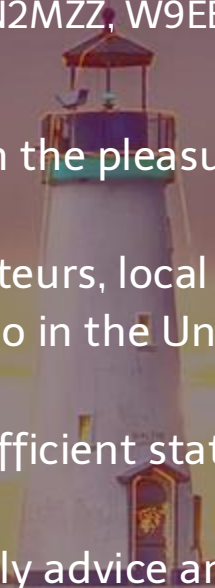

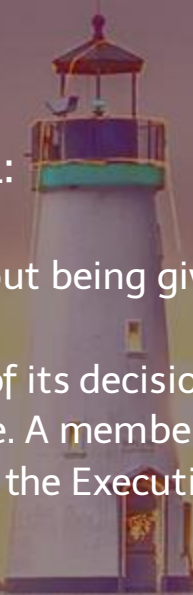

Constitutional Amendment 2019-2020-1

- Executive Emergency Constitutional Revision 2019-2020-E1:
 - Section 5.1 Federal Communications Commission Violations.
 - REPLACE “A member may have his/her membership revoked without being given a chance to voice his/her perspective on the violation.”
 - WITH “The Executive Committee shall give notice to the member of its decision prior to a vote on the question at least three days in advance of the vote. A member may share his/her opinion on the question of his/her membership with the Executive Committee prior to the vote.”



Constitutional Amendment 2019-2020-2

- Earlier elections (handoff in May)
- New director: Asset Manager
- Club powers: remove directors
- Director requirements: recommend and train an understudy
- Spelling and grammar corrections
- Remove unlicensed voting
 - Conversions to licensed voting from Non-Voting \$5 WITH LICENSE, or \$0 if you get licensed during that year
- Year-long membership cycle

1. Preamble: WHEREAS lighthouses have served a continuous and invaluable role in
2. American History;
3. WHEREAS the Texas A&M University Amateur Radio Club values American history
4. and the history of lighthouses;
5. WHEREAS the Texas A&M University Amateur Radio Club recognizes the
6. immeasurable service provided by lighthouses and lighthouse operators in
7. preventing attacks from foreign invasion, aliens, and in preventing safety disasters
8. by providing for safe navigation of waters both domestic and international;
9. WHEREAS the Amateur Radio Lighthouse Society (ARLHS) allows for membership
10. and annually hosts a National Lighthouse and Lightship Weekend (NLLW);
11. WHEREAS the Texas A&M University Amateur Radio Club would benefit from
12. Increased utilization of our present equipment;
13. WHEREAS the Texas A&M University Amateur Radio Club recognizes and shares the
14. values of the ARLHS, such as its goals to “promote public awareness of the role
15. ham radio and light beacons have played in assisting and maintaining safety at
16. sea; to preserve the heritage and history of lighthouses and lightships; to aid in
17. preserving those lights in danger of destruction or decay; to recognize the keepers
18. of the lights as maritime heroes; to foster camaraderie within the ham fraternity;
